- B. Beaufort Elementary School promotes responsible parenting by:
 - a. Provide access to online grading portal for grades 3-12
 - a. Provide interim progress reports and report cards for grade K-12
 - b. Provide opportunities for parent teacher conferences
 - c. Encourage parents to participate in school-based activities
- C. Beaufort Elementary School will involve parents in student learning by:
 - a. Clear and consistent communication regarding academic progress
 - b. Various student-centered meetings that address student strengths and opportunities for growth
- D. Beaufort Elementary School will encourage volunteering in the school by:
 - a. Providing volunteer training
 - b. Offering various school-based volunteer opportunities

- E. Beaufort Elementary School will involve parents in school decisions that affect children and families by inviting and encouraging parents to be on school committees such as:
 - a. PTO (Parent Teacher Organization)
 - b. PAC (Parent Advisory Committee)
 - c. SIT (School Improvement Team)
 - d. Booster Clubs (Athletics, Band, etc.)

- F. Beaufort Elementary School will provide parental training based on parents' informational needs as gathered by:
 - a. Parent Advisory Council Meetings
 - b. Parent Representative on School Improvement Teams
 - c. Student Support Team Meeting Information
